CALL MEETING TO ORDER AT: 7:00 pm. Keil, Sweere, Rudolph, Haverland, and Fulford present.

GOPHER FEET: 29 pair @ \$2.50 per pair for a total of \$72.50 to Penny Tverberg.

LICENSES, PERMITS AND FEES: Mario Alvarado presented requesting additional permit to continue work on home. Since Mario and Blanca had already obtained permits for this work, it was decided that they only need pay \$50 for another permit. However, he was advised to try and do his best to complete this in the 18 months allowed. Check received for \$50. Motion: Rudolph. Second: Sweere. Carried.

MINUTES OF August 7, 2018, MEETING READ by Fulford. Motion: Rudolph. Second: Sweere. Carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT read by Haverland. Balance on hand August 7, 2018, \$404,564.42. 12 checks and 1 ACH written for total of \$26,683.20. Total deposits \$1,126.27. Total cash on hand August 7, 2018, \$379,007.49. Motion: Sweere. Second: Rudolph. Carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Discussed approaches. Stoderl may be reimbursed.

Regarding Theodorson project, Clerk Tellinghuisen has started the paperwork process with the county auditor for the remaining 3 homeowners to be assessed on their taxes. Question of having farm animals also touched on again. Keil to check further, but as stated before, there is no ordinance in place at this time, and it would be the property owners responsibility to keep these animals contained properly.

NEW BUSINESS:

2019 levy paperwork completed. Of the \$250,000 total net levy, 15% or \$37,500 went to General Revenue, 70% or \$175,000 to Road and Bridge, and 15% or \$37,500 to Fire.

Head judge's request for pay increase was discussed. After discussion of options, it was decided to go ahead with increases for all judges. Head judge will be increased to \$16.00/hr and remaining judges to \$14.00/hr. This is to be retroactive to the July 27, 2018, training. Motion: Rudolph. Second: Sweere. Carried.

ROAD REPORT: Stabnow and Sazama absent from meeting but it was reported that all graveling has been completed at a cost of about \$72,000, approx \$60,000 to Curt and \$12,000 to Jamie for additional services, mowing, etc. Road split cost with Edna Township and Rush Lake Township discussed. Haverland to send a copy of our invoice to each of these townships with amounts owed by them, i.e., \$3,706 from Edna Township and \$4,743 from Rush Lake Township. Additionally, Sweere received a voicemail recently regarding the upcoming work next summer on Highway 34 and the detours which will be put in place. In discussion, it was felt no work needed on our roads in preparation for this.
