**Road Report:** Presented by Shawn Sweere. Roads are in decent shape. 460<sup>th</sup> Ave has been the focus. Safety for road maintenance workers is a concern due to high speeds of vehicles. Ditches were mowed by mid July. August focus will be to fill potholes, mow ditches to 15ft starting with roads with a lot of thistles.

**Civil Engineer Report:** Presented by Jeff Stabnow. Jeff is still waiting for information from MNDOT on the cost of signage during work on Fort Thunder. He explained why there was a difference between invoices presented to the Board for the Fort Thunder work – due to retainer. Perham Township could be eligible to receive up to \$10,000 reimbursement from the state for the cost of the MNDOT ROW. There was discussion on how to decrease total monies spent on Fort Thunder. Shawn Sweere made a motion to decline adding mailboxes along Fort Thunder as previously discussed.

#### **BUSINESS DISCUSSION:**

Perham Township has requested assistance from Otter Tail County for road repair on roads impacted when Hwy 34 was closed. Discussion with Craig Tschida from Otter Tail County. Craig requested any records that Perham Township has on work and maintenance on Fort Thunder Rd, 450th Street from 410th ST to Harvest and from 410th St to 400th Ave, and 425th street from Fort Thunder one mile to the line. There was discussion around last year's drought and the impact it had on maintenance of roads.

Barb Felt attended the Gorman and Corliss Monthly Board Meetings to discuss the EMS and taxing district option. Barb recapped Gorman and Corliss Township discussion on topic. There was further discussion on this as Board Members reviewed MN Statutes 144F.01, 144E.101, and 144E.27. It is Board Members understanding that to change to a Taxing District, there needs to be a unanimous vote. The minutes from the JPB meeting in April were reviewed. There will be a Joint Powers Board meeting on August 11<sup>th</sup> at the Perham Township Hall for question/answers.

Discussion of 450<sup>th</sup> Ave south of HWY 10 to add class 5. North Central Inc will add class 5 to 450<sup>th</sup> Avenue and hold off on adding class 5 to MN Street. Maintenance of MN Street will continue.

There was discussion on possible ways to better manage the quality of homes being moved into the Township. Supervisors will look at the Ordinance of this at the special meeting September 15<sup>th</sup>.

Perham Township will post signs in new developments stating that the land is zoned and permits are required.

There was discussion on adding local advertising to the Township website. Any fees charged would offset Township costs.
