NEW BUSINESS:

Determine assessments for residents on Aerovilla Rd. See map for determination of shares. Spread sheet for documentation. Board answered questions of resident of Aerovilla Road; Project is slated to begin in July. It is normal practice of the Contractor to not give exact start date of the project to residents. Bid was accepted with estimated product needs, when project is complete at the end of August, residents will receive a letter with their exact cost per share owned on road. Sealcoating the road is part of the contracted project and cost was included with an assessment estimate that was mailed to Residents in June. Term limits of assessment balances and interest rates for Residents was discussed.
